Other Details of the course:-

- The course will be held at Hotel Mirage, Andheri –Kurla road, Marol, Andheri (E), Mumbai
- The course timings will be from 8.30 A.M to 6.30 P.M with Examination on last day from 2.00 P.M. to 5.00 P.M.
- The course is non residential. Outstation candidates will have to book their own accommodation
- DGM will provide IATA DGR manual for use during the course. If however any candidate wants to bring their own IATA DGR they are welcome to do so, provided it is the latest version.
- Minimum qualification required as per DGCA, for attending the course is Graduation or 10+2 with 3 years of experience as a shipper, shipper's agent or operator's or its handling company's staff engaged in handling, storage or loading of dangerous goods
- 100% attendance is must for appearing for the examination as per DGCA rules. Candidates leaving the course midway will not be allowed to sit in the examination and will forfeit their fees paid.
- 80% marks is necessary to pass the examination. Candidate passing with 90% and above marks will be awarded Pass with Distinction Certificate. If the candidate is appearing for the examination a second time, he will be given a pass certificate even if he scores 90% or more marks in the examination.
- Candidates not passing the examination but having full attendance, will be allowed to sit for the examination in the next course held by DGM India within 3 months of this course. If he wishes to sit for the course again, he will have to pay 75% of the course fee.
